

VIA LINK LAUNCHES VIA CARE, EXPANDING OUR HOMELESSNESS AND CARE NAVIGATION SERVICES VIA LINK has launched VIA CARE, a new program to support unhoused individuals and those at risk of becoming homeless in Orleans and Jefferson parishes. The program is a partnership with Baptist Community Ministries and will provide two types of services. It will offer care navigation by helping people to identify community resources, apply for services and benefits, and follow up to address other needs as they arise.

VIA CARE will also provide ID cards for unhoused individuals to check into shelters and share important information with providers. This will simplify the intake process for shelter staff and cut down on duplication. The program is starting at the



Harry Thompson Center and Ozanam Inn, but eventually can expand to other shelters.







